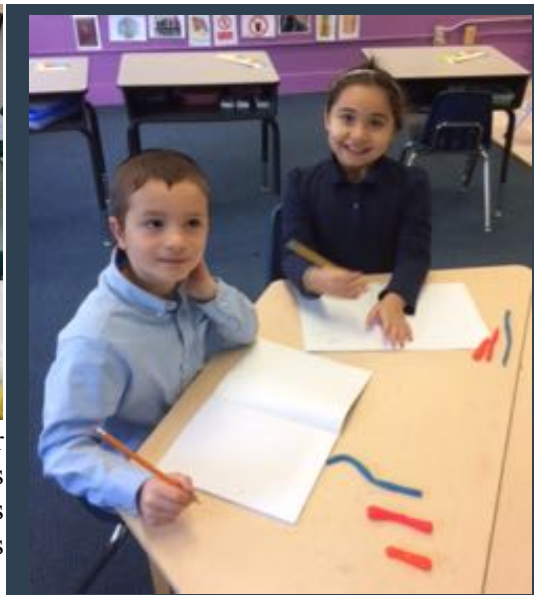
**Alternate pickup arrangements:** If you wish to have another parent or adult pick up your child from school, we must have authorization from you in advance. Please contact the school before 3:30.
